Amendments to CEE3430 Grading

Grading Policy from Syllabus

1. Grades will be based on a weighted average of results as follows:

Homework. 20% Test 1: 25%

Test 2: 25%

Final: 30%.

2. Letter grades will be assigned as follows:

A = 95 - 100%

A = 90 - 95%

B+=87-90%

B = 83 - 87%

B - 80 - 83%

C+ = 77 - 80%

C = 73 - 77%

C = 70 - 73%

D + = 65 - 70%

D = 60 - 65%

F < 60%

These thresholds may be adjusted downwards (in the students favor) at my discretion, but will not be adjusted upwards. I may also adjust a student's letter grade upward if there are indications that such adjustment is warranted (e.g. an improving trend in grades following a poor start).

3. Incomplete grades will not be given except under extenuating circumstances as allowed for by University policy. Incomplete grades will not be given for poor performance.

Amendments

1. Option to not do final. If you opt out of doing the Final Exam I will substitute the average score from the first two tests in place of your final score. This will be computed as

$$\left(\frac{T1}{35} + \frac{T2}{60}\right) * 0.5$$

2. If you do the final exam I will take the best score from the final and average of the two tests as the score for the Final exam

$$Max\left(\left(\frac{T1}{35} + \frac{T2}{60}\right) * 0.5, F\right)$$

3. Extra credit for optional homework. Homework 8 part 2 will be scored as
